PRIMARY PURPOSE

The welder-fitter will need to have manual dexterity and the ability to use hand and power tools as needed. Various welding equipment, will be used, such as MIG, TIG, stick welders, air arc machine and cutting torches. Must be able to read engineering sketches and drawings, understand welding symbols.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND FUNCTIONS

- Lay out, positions, and secures parts and assemblies according to specifications.
- Determines required equipment, welding method and welding techniques.
- Develops templates and other work aids to hold and align parts.
- Ignites torch and adjusts valves, amperage, or voltage to obtain desired flame or arc.
- Tack-welds or welds components and assemblies.
- Heats, forms, and dresses metal parts, using hand tools, torch, or arc welding equipment.
- Welds components in flat, vertical, or overhead positions.
- Removes rough spots from work piece, using portable grinder, hand file, or scraper.
- Inspects grooves, angles, or gap allowances, using micrometer, caliper, and precision measuring instruments.
- Follow blueprints to arrange metal pieces and temporarily fix them into position before welding.
- Keep work area clean and organized.
- Make recommendations for process improvements.
- Perform equipment inspections prior to use.
- Report equipment malfunctions or safety concerns to the Plant and/or Maintenance Manager.
